

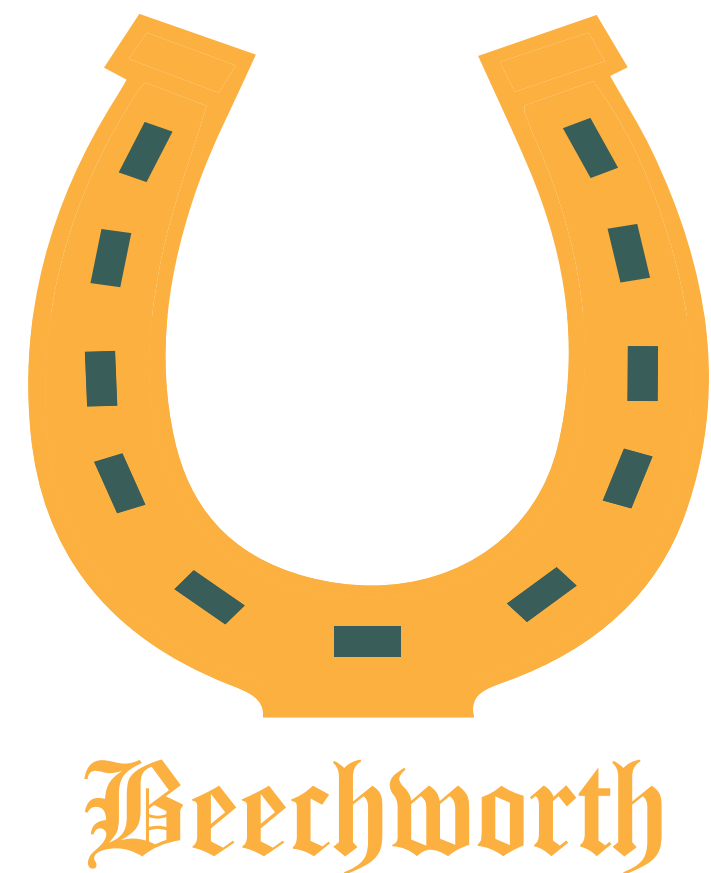
INCLUSION

- Using kind words and kind actions.





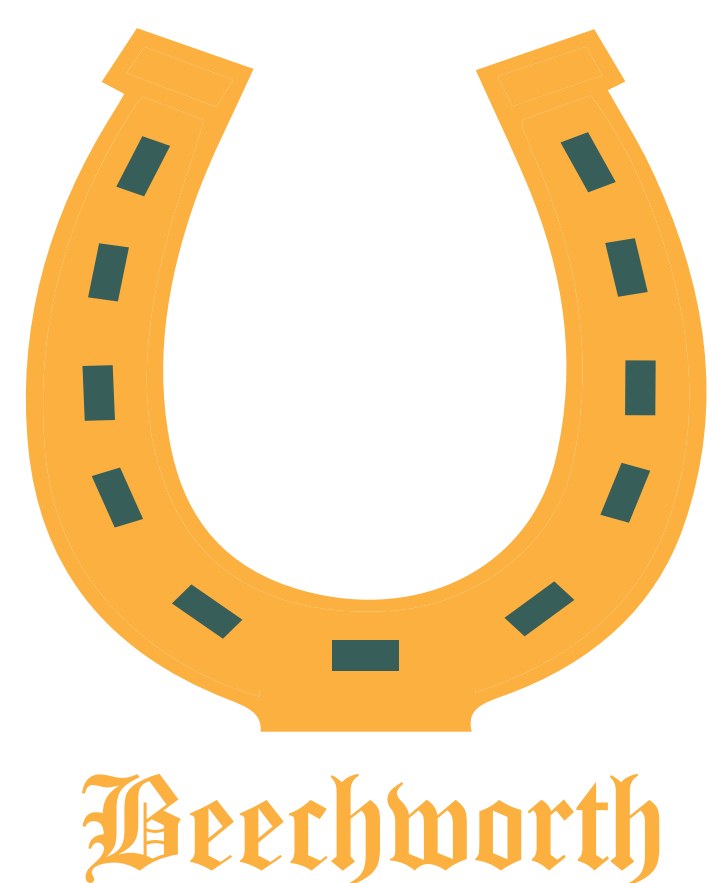
LEARN

- By not continually causing disruptions during our learning time.





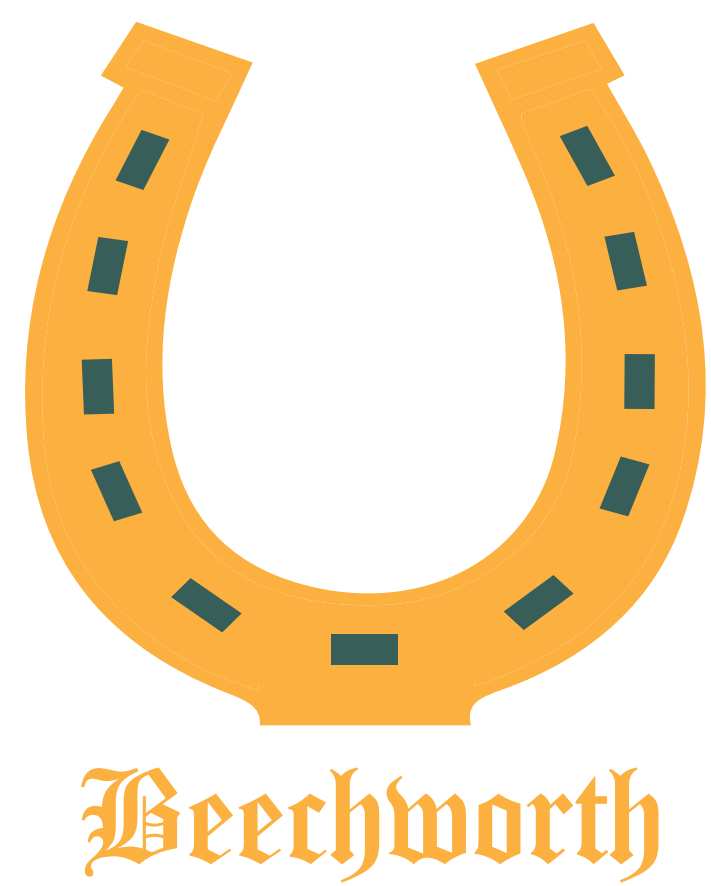
RESPECT
