# Principal's News

Welcome to our Week 4 newsletter.





This week there was much excitement as they opened up our new Junior Playground. There is still a little work to be undertaken in the space, but we have access to the sandpit and the climbing frames. ## **School Council Elections**

School Council contributes towards governance of the school and is an important component in ensuring the big picture is achieved. Each year, we ask parents to nominate for positions on Council, to help us achieve our parent membership. Our School Council comprises 7 Parent Representatives, 4 Staff Representatives (including the Principal) and a community member (if available).

Nominations for new School Council Members opens Monday 27<sup>th</sup> February and closes Monday 6<sup>th</sup> March.

This year, our vacant positions are:

- three parent positions, each position has a duration of 2 years.
- one community member position with a duration of 1 year.

If you wish to be part of this governing board of our school, please drop by the school office and pick-up a School Council Nomination form. Please note that we are only able to have one DET employed parent as a representative.

Where there are more nominations than the number of vacancies a ballot will be held following the closing date for nominations. School Council is a great way of being involved in many aspects of Beechworth PS. Full details of the SC Election process is attached.

## NAPLAN 2023 for Year 3 & 5 Students

As you may be aware, the NAPLAN testing window is approaching. Our school was transitioned to Online NAPLAN Assessment in 2022. NAPLAN Online has a test window from Wednesday 15th March – Friday 24th March. However, with our school schedule we aim to have all tests finalised within the first week.

Standardised tests are a snapshot of a student's academic progress on a given day. Beechworth Primary School endeavours to provide a supporting and non-threatening approach to the tests. However, parents with concerns regarding NAPLAN, or who wish to withdraw their child will need to speak directly with their child's teacher, or to Scott Forrest, the school's NAPLAN Co-Ordinator.

Last week all Year 3 and Year 5 students should have brought home an information letter with more detailed information regarding this year's NAPLAN online. Please ensure, as parents and carers, you are well informed and contact us for any further questions or clarification you might have.

This was the Dragon Boat Victoria Lunar New Year Regatta, the first of two State Championship Regattas.



Heidi is in the Victorian Junior State Dragon Boat Team, as well as the local team, Beechworth Golden Serpents. She paddles in some races, and in others, she is on the drum, which is a really important role that requires her to loudly relay instructions to the paddlers as well as keeping time on the drum. She often races in an adult crew.

At the State Championships she raced with the Golden Serpents, who came home with two silver and one bronze trophies. She also drummed with the Victorian Junior Team, who convincingly beat several adult crews and gave the navy team a good run for their money.

It was fantastique!








# Stages of election


The election process needs to start at least 21 days before the poll closing date. The following are indicative stages of the process.






# Tuning in to Kids Emotionally intelligent parenting
