Victorian High Ability Program (VHAP)

The VHAP enables high-ability students in Years 5-8, at Victorian State Schools, to be challenged and extended in their learning. The Extension programs that the form of an online classroom from across Victoria. They are 10 weeks in length and are run online by a high ability trained teacher, with the support of a BPS teacher (myself this year). The VHAP offers the students the opportunity to explore and express their ideas freely, be inspired and challenged by each other, and to feel excited about their learning.



Places in the program are offered through a VHAP department selection process based on NAPLAN data and teacher judgements in the students school reports, to those who have performed to a high level.

It has been my pleasure to work with Karima Abdalla and Grace White this term on the VHAP Writing Program. Grace has also been offered a position in the Mathematics Program for Term 2. Congratulations to both of these students on their excellent achievements.

Unique image codes will be issued to all students on/after photo day so families can register online to view images when they become available in the webshop.


Registration is simple, just follow the 3 simple steps on your child's personalised flyer once you receive it and remember to add the codes for all your children attending this school.


