Welcome to our Week 3 Newsletter.

The year is slipping by quickly and on Tuesday 1st August, our Foundation students will be celebrating 100 days of School! It has been wonderful to see them settle in their classroom, work hard on their learning and build beautiful friendships.

Early Arrivals at School

Recently we have noticed an increase in early arrivals at school. This is becoming increasingly problematic with students playing unsupervised, competitive ball games, which sees them becoming argumentative and 'heightened' before entering the classroom. Some students are entering the yard well before 8:30am.

Our playground is open from 8:45am each day, which is when staff commence yard duty. If your child needs to be at school earlier than 8.45 they should be accessing the provided OSHC service - TheirCare (contact details are below). Students arriving before 8.45 who are not booked into TheirCare will now be required to come to the seating area in front of the school where they will sit with Mrs Mac until 8.45.

Transition

It is amazing to already have arrived at that time when we look forward to the coming year as we commence transition from Primary Schooling to Secondary for our Year 6 students. Thursday we had a visit from Alex and Taylor, teachers from Beechworth Secondary College to talk with our students about secondary school, what will happen for transition and to answer burning questions. It is such an exciting time for them.
