
Book Week and Grandparents' Day - 25 August

Parent Opinion Survey

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what parents and caregivers think of our school. The Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education that is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of families' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour, and student engagement. Our families are invited to participate in the survey. The Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey will be open from Monday 21 August to Friday 8 September 2023.

The survey will be conducted online, only takes 20 minutes to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the survey period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in English and 10 other languages including Arabic, Greek, Hakha Chin, Hindi, Japanese, Punjabi, Simplified Chinese, Somali, Turkish, and Vietnamese. The link to the survey will be sent home via Compass this week.

Essential Assessment

Essential Assessment is an online mathematics and literacy learning and assessment tool used in the classrooms at Beechworth Primary School. Through this online program students can practice skills at their individual level and extend their learning through targeted and supported questioning in the My Numeracy and My Literacy (My Literacy is for Grade 3-6 only) areas. As a school we currently provide this tool to all students to use in the classroom.

Through the school's voluntary contribution program families have the opportunity to help the school pay for their child's subscription. These contributions allow us to continue to use the program at school.

We are now encouraging families who have contributed to the school's voluntary contribution program to use this resource at home. Students will have access to the 'My Numeracy' and 'My Literacy' (My Literacy is for Grade 3-6 only) sections and here they can engage in activities based on their learning needs. Through the 'My Learning' and 'Learn' links students and families can access support for managing challenging concepts.
