Consent forms are due by 15 September.



He loves his food and thinks he is the boss.





Pixie loves her food almost as much as HayHay.




Trixie is the smallest out of all them. Safe to say she is the shy one always waiting for others to finish before she starts to eat.

Hoping she comes out of her shell a little










