#### St John's First Aid in Schools

The knowledge and skills gained in the First Aid in Schools Program develops First Aid awareness in school children and contributes to building a more resilient community. This learning is age-appropriate and integrates with the Victoria Curriculum F-10.



Today, each class participated in a 45 minute lesson with content appropriate to their age and year level. Students learnt how to help out in an emergency. Renee and Alycia from St John's First Aid have been working with each class throughout the day. The students have been learning the following:

- Foundation students worked through a story called 'The day Johnny Bear became a Superhero'. They talked about what an emergency is, learnt how to keep themselves safe, and how to be a superhero by knowing how to call for help.
- The Year 1 and 2 students learnt about the early steps in a slightly more formal way, those being danger to self and others, how to check for a response and how to seek help.
- The Year 3 and 4 classes worked through checking for danger, checking for a response, how to call for help, then checking for breathing and how to put a person into the recovery position.
- The Year 5 and 6 classes worked through the full DRSABC. They learnt about when to give chest compressions, and how to deliver chest compressions. They used first aid mannequins to have a go at delivering compressions.

#### **Foundation 2024 Transition**

We were very excited to start our transition to school program for our 2024 Foundation students this week. The transition program will gradually introduce our preschool children to 'big' school in order to gain confidence in their ability to independently experience school life. Our new students were met by their buddies and introduced to the classroom. Our Foundation Transition program continues again next Tuesday with another 2-hour session (9.00-11.00). We can't wait to see you all again!

This week we drew 2 amazing Ruby Safety winners Mia Fitridge and Lily Watson (we missed last week due to the short week). We then drew our winner of the Big Prize, congratulations to Cain Heaton!


